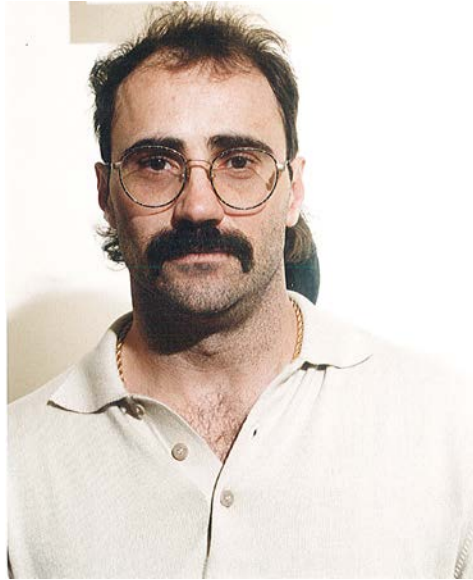

Summary:

On 10-Oct-98 CARRIERE was out drinking with a group friends when an argument started between CARRIERE and one of the males in the group. The argument escalated to the point where CARRIERE entered his vehicle and reversed out of a parking spot, striking a snowmobile that had been pulled out of CARRIERE's vehicle. Another argument started and the rest of the group attempted to stop the argument. CARRIERE once again reversed his vehicle, this time running over the leg of one of the males in the group. CARRIERE stopped his vehicle momentarily then sped off. As a result CARRIERE was arrested for fail to remain and criminal negligence causing bodily harm.

On 05-Feb-99 while Police were driving through a parking lot they observed a vehicle come around the corner of the building and was driving head on towards the police vehicle, Police stopped their vehicle and the other vehicle swerved and stopped. The driver of the vehicle was identified as CARRIERE. Police noted that CARRIERE's eyes were bloodshot, speech was slurred and face was flushed. CARRIERE was arrested for impaired operation of a motor vehicle. While attempting to provide a sample of his breath CARRIERE failed to provide a suitable sample, as a result he was charged with fail to comply with breath demand.

On 25-Feb-99 CARRIERE entered a home that he and another male had been hired in the past to do work on. While in the home CARRIERE stole a large amount of money. As a result a warrant was issued for CARRIERE for break enter and theft and theft over \$5,000.

On 09-Mar-99 and 12-Jul-99 CARRIERE fail to attend court and as a result a warrant was issued for CARRIERE's arrest.
